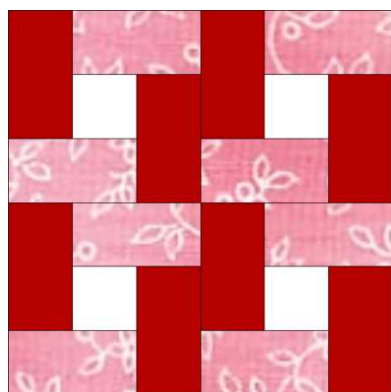
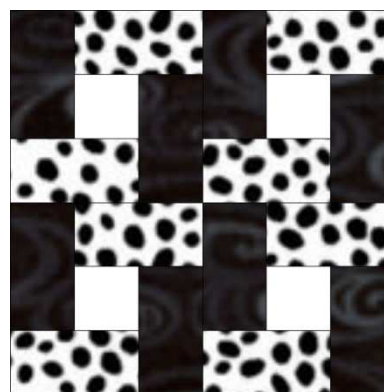


Block of the Month for August 2011



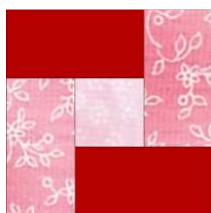
Bright Hope Block



Instructions:

The center square should be white. The rectangles should be cut from medium print colors and dark solid colors. Scrappy look in any color but print and solid of coordinating colors.

1. Cut four $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares from white.
2. Cut eight $2\frac{1}{2}$ by $4\frac{1}{2}$ inch rectangles from a medium print fabric.
3. Cut eight $2\frac{1}{2}$ by $4\frac{1}{2}$ inch rectangles from a dark solid fabric.
4. Sew a rectangle to the center square leaving at least $\frac{1}{2}$ " un-sewn at the extra fabric end, continue around the square in log cabin fashion -- as shown in the graphic.
5. Repeat three times.



5. After adding the fourth rectangle,
finish the seam from the first rectangle.
6. Join the four quarters together to form the block.

Your completed unfinished block will measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ inches.

Twelve inches after sewn into a quilt!
