

Puyallup Valley Quilter's August Block of the Month

Enjoy your July 4th with your family we will see you on the 11th. I am doing the last quilt block for this geometric series with a yellow block in the middle. I will have a quilt put together of my blocks of the year hopefully soon using many more ideas outside of the last 12 months.

I will be making this last block an easy one. I just discovered a way to make it more creative. All's fair in the spontaneity of creativity. Let's get started.

Pick 3 colors. A yellow center and 2 blending colors.

Cut 2 ½ inch square of each of the 3 materials. Sew the 3 squares in a row with the yellow in the middle. Cut 2 strips of 2 ½ inches wide by 3 inches long of each of the 2 materials. Sew each of the two colors together on the 2 ½ inch end for either side of the middle strip with the yellow center.

Crease the center of the yellow square strip so that the seam of the two material strips can meet it in the middle. Sew one strip to one side and one to the other matching up the same colors as the middle strip. Square it up to 5 ½ inch square. To make it more creative cut the middle block off center or longer/shorter on the two sides. I did it by accident. Oops (:
