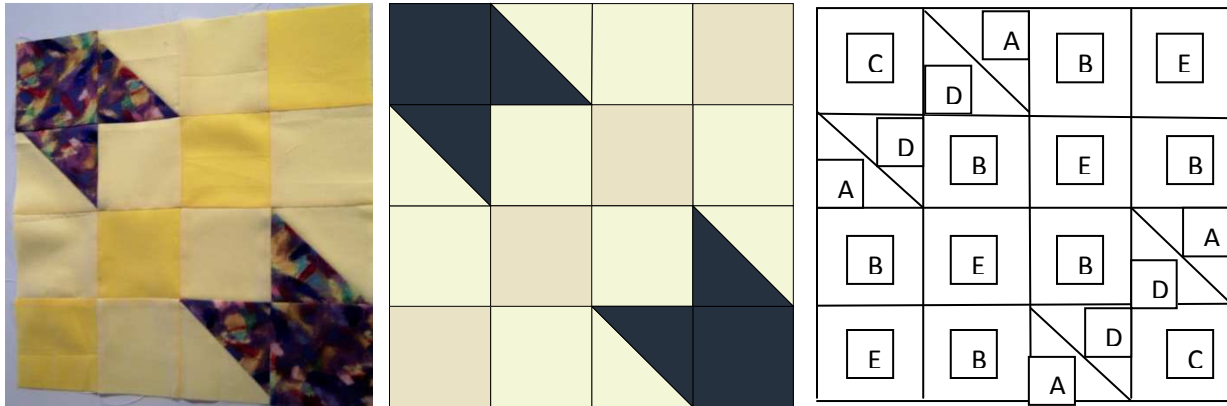


Block of the Month for Jan 2009

Wings of Comfort



This is a very simple block, but when you put together you will see a very nice design.

A & B are background cream on cream material

C & D are the dark value material

E is medium value - a plain material or small overall design would work best to be effective.

A – cut two (2) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ inch squares of background fabric and cut the squares in half diagonally.

B – cut six (6) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ inch squares of background fabric

C – cut two (2) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ inch squares of dark value fabric

D – cut two (2) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ inch squares of dark value fabric and cut the squares in half diagonally.

E – cut four (4) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ inch squares of medium value fabric.

Sew A to D and press seam towards the dark fabric. Square this unit up to $3 \frac{1}{2}$ inch square.

Lay out squares according to the diagram. Sew the top row together and press seams to the right.

Sew the second row together and press seams to the left. The Third row press seams to the right and the fourth row press seams to the left.

Sew rows together. Press seams and square the block to $12 \frac{1}{2}$ inches.
