"20th Century Quilts" by Beverly Dunivent - July 7, 2010

Beverly Dunivent from Olympia is a quilt historian, collector, teacher, lecturer and an appraiser certified by the American Quilter's Society. She served as a consultant to RJR Fashion fabrics for 1930s reproduction fabrics and her articles have been featured in many publications.

Beverly will be speaking to us about the quilts of the 20th Century. She will be showing the actual quilts of this most quilt active century of all time. She will begin with a stunning wool crazy quilt that is dated 1904 and show some samples of quilts that were used in the Temperance campaign of the early century. From there she will show the quilts of the big revival of the 1920's and 30's. There will be both traditional and innovative quilts including kit quilts and a beautiful silk quilt. She will show a quilt from the 2nd World War along with the changing quilting styles of the 1940's and 50's. She will show a dated house quilt from 1960 along with her first quilt make in 1985. Her talk will be full of stories and humor as she takes us back to the century that came to an end 10 years ago. She will also answer questions and look at the quilts that guild members bring.

It Was Voted:

May 11 2010 minutes were approved as corrected for the library report. The correction is "...where she purchased 35 new books for the library for \$173.00.", not \$143.80.

Treasurer Report: Joanne Roth. The Treasurer Report was passed out and reviewed. Joanne reviewed some of the topics covered in the seminar. One item pointed out is that nonprofit organizations should file taxes every year but every 3 years at a minimum. If this isn't done the organization can lose its nonprofit status.

Library: Diana Friesz reported that the books sold in June book sale netted \$405. Diana also reported that she sold 9 books on Amazon.com for \$193.

Membership: Patricia Faller. Patricia reported that there are currently 168 members. She will Provide Kim Smith a membership renewal form in the newsletter for July.

Programs: Gail Mikuchonis. Gail reported that Beverly Donovan will be the speaker for July.
