

Puyallup Valley Quilter's July Block of the Month

Remember we are meeting July 11th instead of July 4th for obvious reasons. Enjoy your holiday. We are making a holiday block so get out those red, whites and blues. I call it "A Crazy 9 Patch." The easiest way to do this block is to do foundational piecing but I experimented and it can be done by template. Figure out your design by color-I did red, white and blue in that order and then rotated the next row down one color eg blue, red, and white. Mark your color on the pattern. Each 9 patch could be it's own material or you could use just 3 colors.

If you like the template method, an easy way is to cut out the individual middle sections with the seam allowance, then sew the two colors to it, and then cut and sew it all together. It is a freeing way but may show more variety if you were concerned with exactness. Be creative and enjoy.
