Minutes of May 11, 2010 PVQ Board Meeting

Meeting was called to order by President Elaine Ducken at 7:05PM. Also present were Joanne Roth, Kim Smith, Gail Mikuchonis, Helen Meeker, Diana Friesz, Patricia Faller, JoAnn James, and Donna Graham

It Was Voted:

April 13, 2010 minutes were approved as written

Treasurer Report: Joanne Roth. The Treasurer Report was passed out and reviewed. Joanne will be attending the IRS seminar for non-profits Wednesday 5/12/10.

Block of the Month: Helen Meeker. Helen showed a sample of July's block which is called School Girls Puzzle.

Community Service: The sale of fat quarters and ½ yard fabric at the Cascade retreat resulted in \$356 to go towards community service.

Fat Quarter: Karen Rose. The board discussed that due to lack of participation, that it should be put to a vote as to whether this committee should continue.

Library: Diana Friesz: Diana shared that they will have books and magazines on sale in June. A group of ~9 PVQ members took a trip up to Martingale, where she purchased 35 new books for the library for \$143.80. Diana also shared that she has sold 8 books on amazon.com and has made \$143.80 for the library. There is an opening for someone to help out in the library during the meetings.

Membership: Patricia Faller: Patricia reported that there are currently 167 members.

Programs: Gail Mikuchonis: Gail indicated that there will be no speaker for June meeting due to the library book sale, and potluck.

Raffles: Gail Mikuchonis: Gail shared that we need still need a custodian for the Raffle quilt. Gail also shared that she is currently working on the design of a new raffle quilt. Gail mentioned that the fish bowl raffle is not working and Elaine agreed to bring up for a vote whether to continue this raffle at the June meeting.

Workshops: Gail Mikuchonis: Gail indicated that there will be a workshop coming up in August on fabric dying.

Old Business:
