

Puyallup Valley Quilter's June Block of the Month

I would like to encourage you all to be a part of this block of the month so I am making this very simple. But it looks good. I have 2 ways to do this so you may pick one or the other.

Begin by picking 3 fabrics that go together. Cut the background to 5 ½ inch square. Then cut the next fabric 4 inch square or so. The next one can be 2 ½ inch square. Lay them centered best you can and sew a line through the center. If you would like to, you may sew it on the diagonal or from the middle of the sides. Turn the fabric and sew the next diagonal or from the middle of the other side thus making a plus or cross.

The other option is to cut the background material 5 ½ inch square. Cut 4 squares 2 inches wide. Then center the small squares so that all 4 squares have some space between them. Sew it on the diagonal or from the middle of the edges. Turn the material so that each material is sewn with a plus or a cross.

For variety you may use a colored thread. And don't worry about imperfection as that is part of the creativity once the blocks get sewn together.
