Brenda became a compulsive quilter in the mid-80s, and began teaching quilting in 1989, after her third child turned one. Writing and self-publishing that work have been byproducts of teaching quilting. Brenda is the author of numerous books and individual patterns available under the label Bear Paw Productions.

Create your own Baltimore Album quilt without the turned-under edges of traditional appliqué. This 20" block design starts with a 25 patch-pieced background. The design fabric pieces are then adhered to the background using Roxanne Glue-Baste-It and spray stabilizer is applied to the fabric before stitching. Completion of the quilt top will be discussed but not worked on in class
