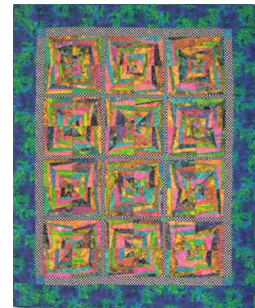

Here is the recipe for my raspberry bars. I'm blushing, they are so easy.

Raspberry Bars

- 1 yellow cake mix
- 2 1/2 cups oatmeal
- 1 1/2 sticks marg. melted
- 1 cup raspberry jam
- 1 tsp. hot water

Mix cake mix with oatmeal. Stir in melted butter, mix well. Press 1/2 into a greases 9 X 13 pan. Mix jam with hot water to thin it a little. Spread over mixture in pan. Sprinkle the rest of oat mixture over the jam. Lightly pat down so the top is rather even. Bake 375 degrees for 20 to 25 minutes. Cool, and cut into bars.
