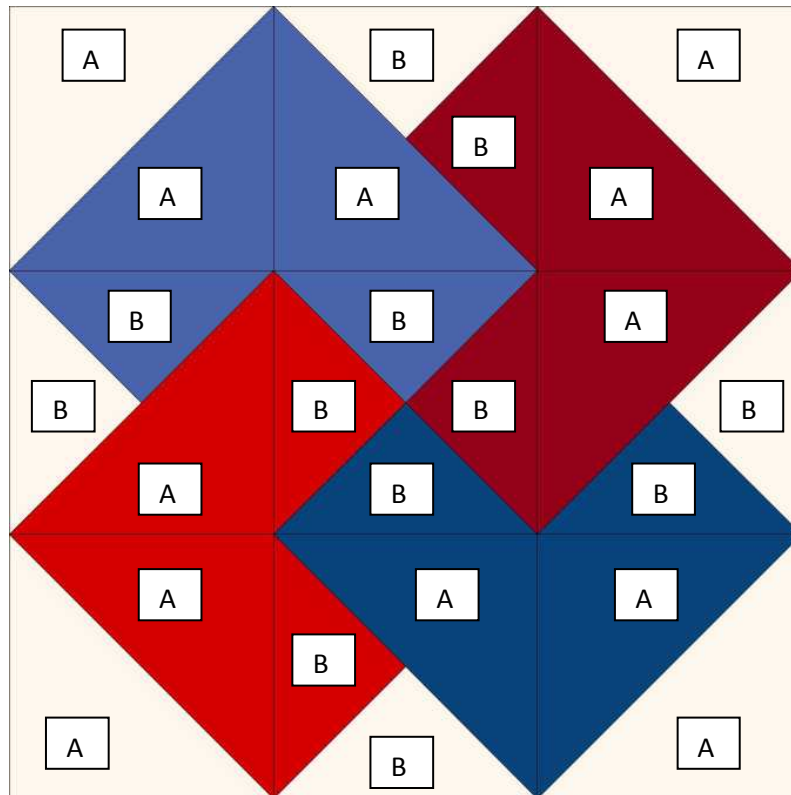


Block of the Month for November 2009

Card Trick Quilt Block

The Card Trick Quilt Block features interlocking squares in a playful, geometric design. The Card Trick block has four "cards" that appear to overlap. Please use a different color for each card with a background fabric of off-white or light cream.



To make the Card Trick Quilt Block:

Cut:

From 4 contrast fabrics: A: Cut one 3 7/8" square, cut each square in half once diagonally.

From 4 contrast fabrics: B: Cut one 4 3/16" square, cut each square in half twice diagonally.


From background fabric: A: Cut two 3 7/8" square, cut each square in half once diagonally.

From background fabric: B: Cut one 4 3/16" square, cut each square in half twice diagonally.

Stitch:

Place all pieces on table as shown on pattern. Arrange components into three rows, making sure like-fabrics touch each other as shown.

Stitch center B's together.

Stitch background A to contrast A; make 4.  Half square triangle units that measure 3-1/2" square

Stitch background B to contrast B; make 4.  Stitch A to contrasting BB; make 4. 

Sew components of each row together. Press adjoining seams in opposite directions and sew rows together. Unfinished block is 9 1/2 inches square. Finished block is 9 inches square.
