

Puyallup Valley Quilter's November Block of the Month/ 2007

So for our second block we are using Sharon Craig's idea of a hexagon that I saw in her quilt last month. Did you see it? It was the quilt on the cover. Inspiration comes to us from many sources. Where is your inspiration? Keep it and be creative.

We will be using dark and medium blues and browns. Then use an off-white material as the light fabric.

Cut 4 off-white squares, and one dark blue, one medium blue, one dark brown and one medium brown. The squares should be 4 inches square.

We will use a pencil to draw on the off white fabric a diagonal line and then to draw just under $\frac{1}{4}$ inch sewing line beside each side. Match the off whites to each of the other colors. Sew on the sewing line. Then we will cut the middle line. Press the triangles open.

We will lay out the colors according to the diagram. And finish up sewing the block thus making a square. Mine was just under 7 inches square.
