

Block of the Month for October 2011



Antique Tile



Cutting Instructions:

Light: Four 4-1/2" x 2-1/2" "rectangles

Medium: Four 2-1/2" squares, Four 4-1/2" x 2-1/2" "rectangles

Dark: Four 4-1/2" x 2-1/2" "rectangles, Four 2-1/2" squares

Center: Yellow One 4-1/2" square

Step 1. Sew one of the 2 1/2" Medium squares and one of the 2 1/2" dark squares right sides together in pairs, using a scant 1/4" seam. Press seam to darker side. You will be making four units like this.



Sew one dark 4 1/2" X 2 1/2: rectangle to the side of the square pairs, two to the left

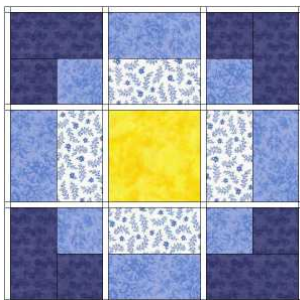


and two on the right, with the dark square on the bottom in each case. Press seam towards rectangle. These will be the block's four corner units.

Step 2. Sew one of the medium 4 1/2" X 2 1/2" rectangles and one light 4 1/2" X 2 1/2" rectangles



together using a scant 1/4" seam. Press seam to darker side. Make four two color units for the block's sides.



Step 3. Now piece the block! Lay out all your units as shown at left, and then sew three horizontal rows. Press top and bottom row seams towards the outsides, and center row seam towards the middle. Then join the rows! Finished 12" block (unfinished 12 1/2")
