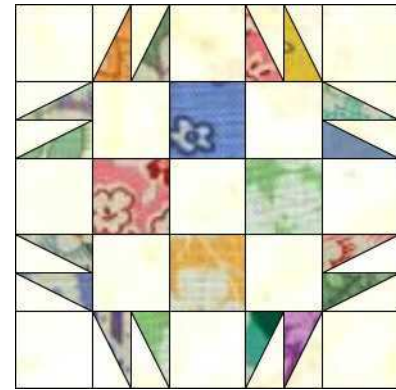


# Block of the Month for August 2010



## Pigeon Toes

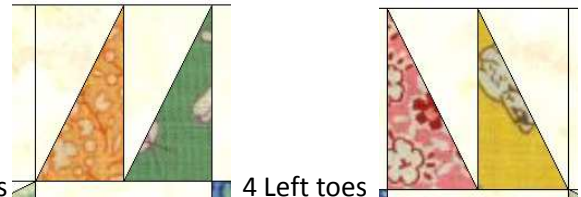


Reproduction prints are a colorful option for this fun block.

Let's make a scrappy version using 30's & 40's prints with at least 8 different fabrics and a basic white for background.

Background cut Thirteen  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and enough for 16 paper pieced "toe" units approximately  $5" \times 2\frac{1}{4}"$ .

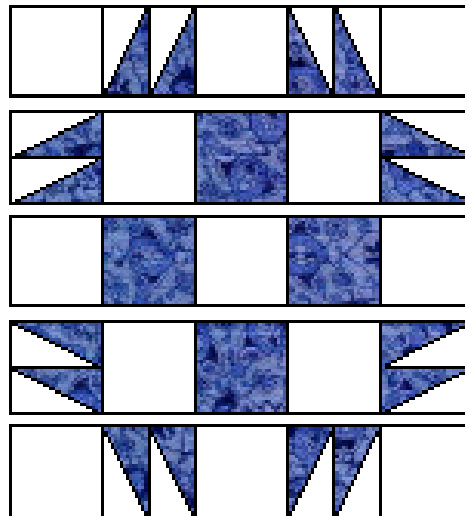
Prints cut  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from four different prints. Use as many as possible of prints to make 16 different



paper pieced "toe" units approximately  $5" \times 2\frac{1}{4}"$ . 4 Right toes

4 Left toes

Second page with 2 Right and 2 Left Paper pieced patterns; you will want two copies of page two.



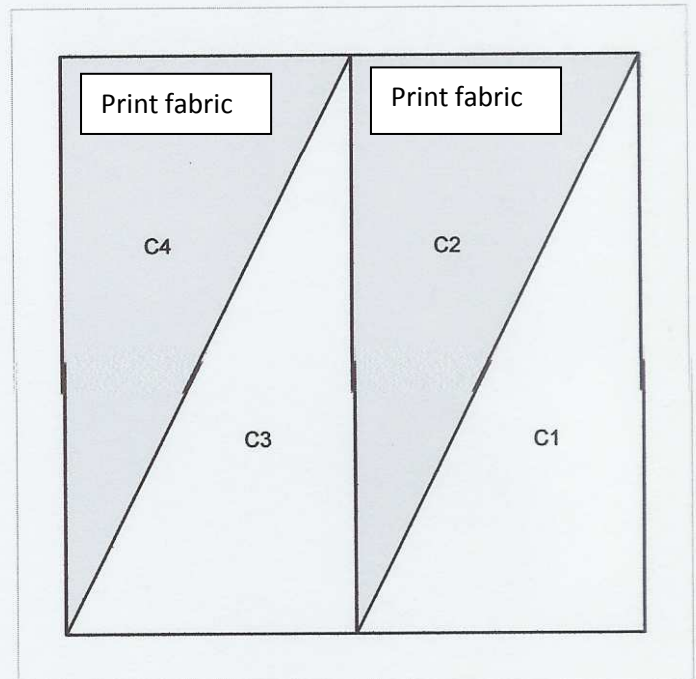
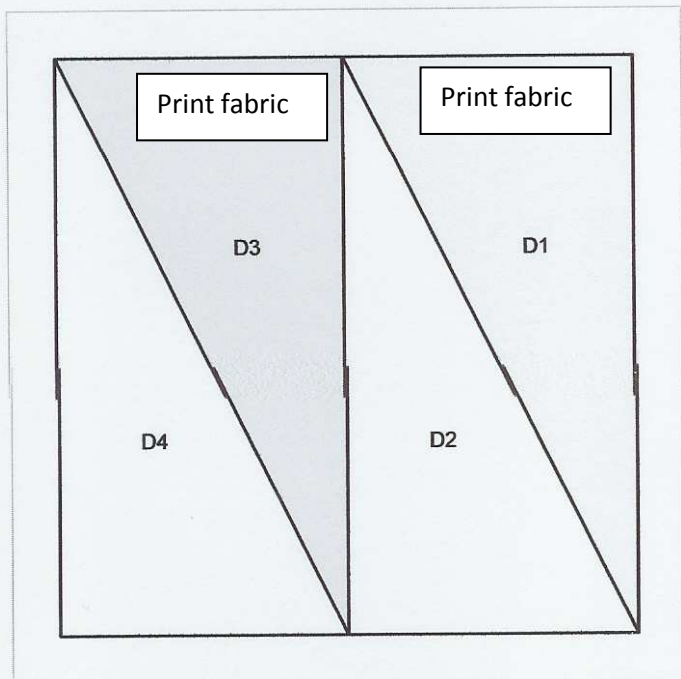
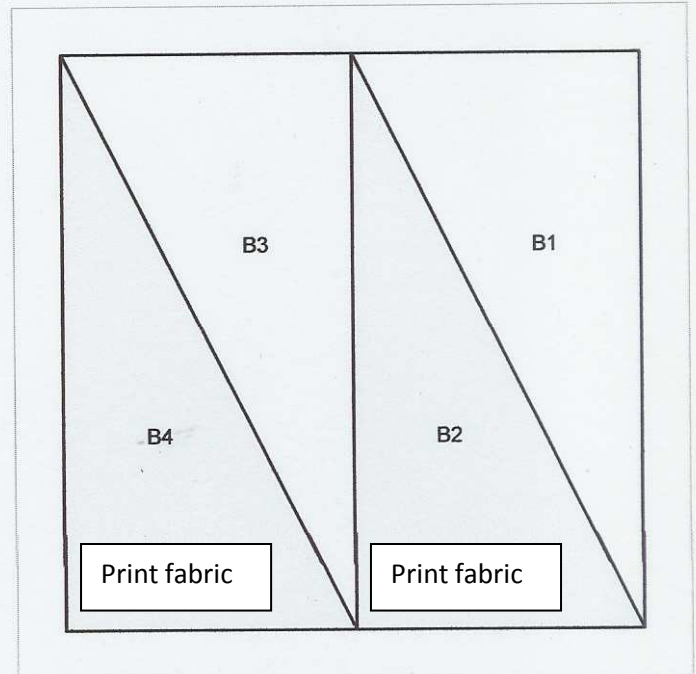
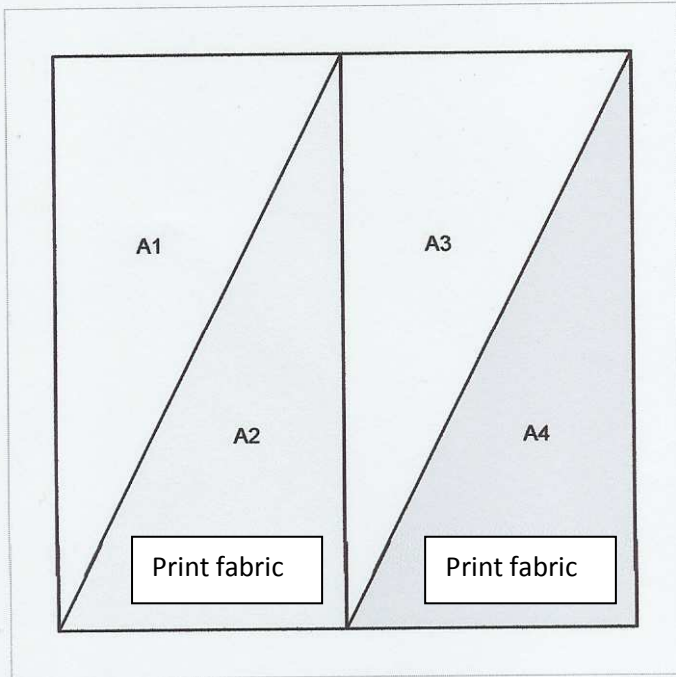
Now using the squares you just cut plus the paper pieced "toe" units, sew rows, using as always SCANT  $1/4"$  seams, and alternating pressing directions with each addition. Join the rows to make the block! :o)
