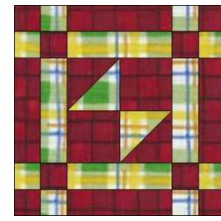


# Block of the Month for January 2012



## Moth in the Window



Bust your stash of recycled fabric with this simple block. Try this block by matching one color to another color you wouldn't normally find yourself putting together.

### Cutting:

Print #1: one 1 1/2" X 32" strip, One (A) 2 7/8" square, Two (B) 2 1/2" squares.

Print #1: One 1 1/2" X 32" strip, One (A) 2 7/8" Square

### Sewing:

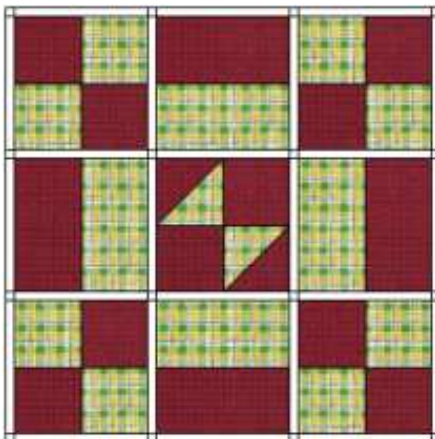
Pair the two 2 7/8" (A) square right sides together, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner, and stitch 1/4" on both sides of drawn line. Cut in half on drawn line. Press to darker fabric and square up to 2 1/2" squares. This makes two for "Moth" in center of block.

Sew together with two 2 1/2" squares (B).

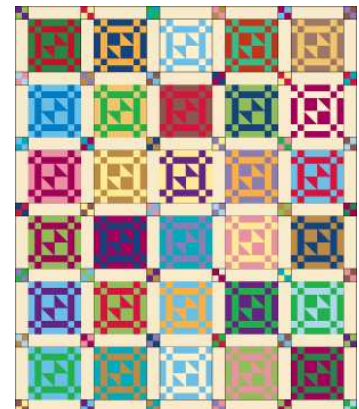
Sew the 1 1/2" X 32" strips together to make band, press to darker fabric.

Cut the band at 4 1/2" intervals to make 4 unit 2's (sides) and

Cut at the 1 1/2" intervals to make 8 unit 3's. to make 4 patch units (Corners).



Sew units together as pictured.



Lots of creative fabrics make this a fun quilt.
