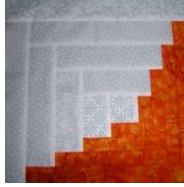
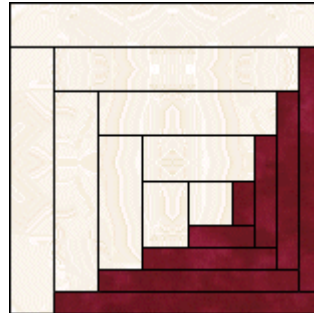
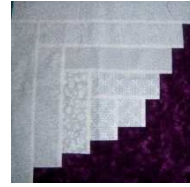


# Block of the Month for June 2010

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Off set Log Cabin

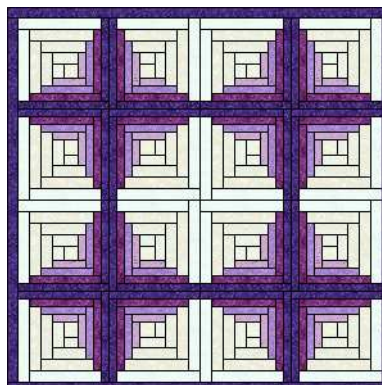


Center square is White 2" square,

Cut White fabric: 2 strips of fabric 2" x width of fabric (generally 42" of useable fabric after selvages are removed). Logs are 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ ", 4  $\frac{1}{8}$ ", 4  $\frac{3}{4}$ ", 6  $\frac{1}{4}$ ", 6  $\frac{7}{8}$ ", 8  $\frac{5}{8}$ ", 9  $\frac{1}{4}$ ", & 10  $\frac{3}{4}$ " long.

Cut Purple fabric: 2 strips of fabric 1  $\frac{1}{4}$ " X width of fabric (WOF) Logs are 2, 3  $\frac{1}{4}$ ", 4  $\frac{1}{8}$ ", 5  $\frac{3}{4}$ ", 6  $\frac{1}{4}$ ", 7  $\frac{1}{8}$ ", 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ ", & 9  $\frac{3}{8}$ " long.

Sew: Working clockwise around the center (White 2") square, with a consistently accurate  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam, first add a Purple 1- $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 2" strip. Press out the seam and add the next longest Purple 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip (3- $\frac{1}{4}$ ") to the bottom of that. Press out the seam and add the shortest White 2" strip (2  $\frac{3}{4}$ ") to the left side. Press out that seam and add the next longest White 2" strip to the top. Press that out and add the next longest Purple 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the right side....and continue in this manner, adding longer and longer strips clockwise 'til all strips have been added, four to each side of center square. Unfinished block should measure 10  $\frac{3}{4}$ " square.
