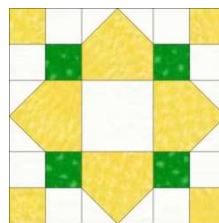


Block of the Month for June 2011





Quatrefoil



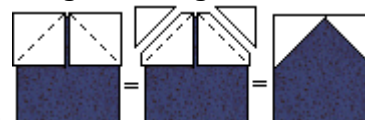
Cutting:

Color 1  Green needs one 2 1/2" X 10" strip.

Color 2  White needs one 4 1/2" square, one 2 1/2" X 10" strip and eight 2 7/8" squares.

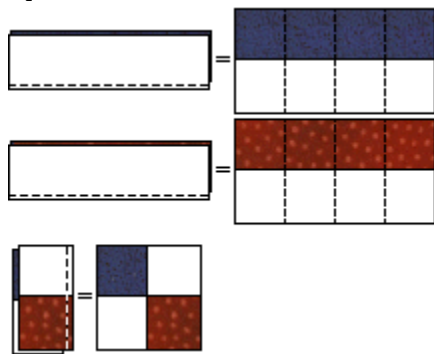
Color 3  Yellow needs one 2 1/2" X 10" strip and four 4 1/2" squares.

To sew the block's side units, first place a Color 2 White 2 7/8" square right side together and outer

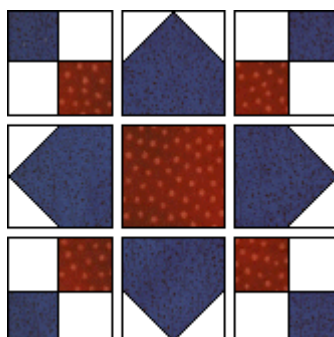


edges aligned with the upper left corner of a Color 3 Yellow square.

Lightly draw in the diagonal on the back of the small square and sew ON that drawn line. Cut off the excess seam allowance, pressing the remainder towards the corner. Repeat this with another Color 2 White square on the upper right corner. Make four units like this. These should measure 4 1/2" squares.



Next sew together a Color 2 white and Color 1 green 2 1/2" X 10" strip along one long edge in a scant 1/4" seam. Press to the darker side. Cut this apart at the 2 1/2" intervals to make four pieced units. Repeat this with Color 2 white and Color 3 Yellow strips to make four more pieced units in that color arrangement. Now sew together one of each color to make a four patch, again using a scant 1/4" seam. Press seam to one side. Make four units like these. These should measure 4 1/2" squares.



Now lay out all units as shown. Sew three horizontal rows, pressing the top and bottom rows to the outside, and the middle row to the center. Join the rows to complete your Quatrefoils block. Block should measure 12 1/2" unfinished.
