Here is a fun optical illusion. Can you make it work with your sewing machine or hand stitching? We will outline a Necker Cube first discovered and published in 1832 by Swiss crystallographer Louis Albert Necker.

Cut a plain fabric 5 ½ inch square. I traced the necker cube outline with a ruler and mechanical pencil-(there are quilting pencils) on the window with a ruler and it showed through. Then I choose to hand sew one example and machine sew the other. You do what works for you. Happy simple stitching.
