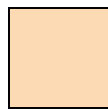
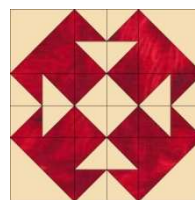


Block of the Month for May 2011



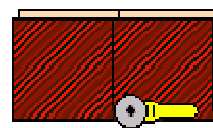
Double T Block



Color 1 Cream (Off White): Cut one 4-7/8" x 9-3/4" strip AND one 2-7/8" x 28-3/4" strip.



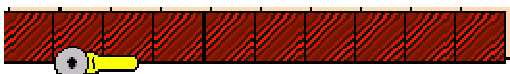
Color 2 Red: cut one 4-7/8" x 9-3/4" strip AND one 2-7/8" x 28-3/4" strip.

Stack the fabrics one white and one red one 4-7/8" x 9-3/4" strip right sides together. Cut into two 4-7/8" squares.

Stack one white and one red 2-7/8" x 28-3/4" strip right sides together.

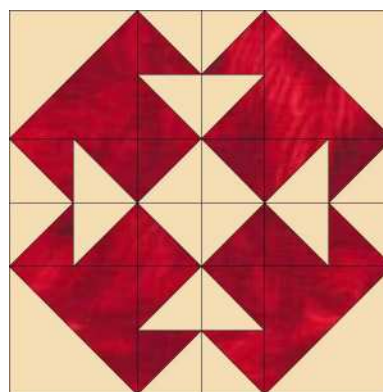
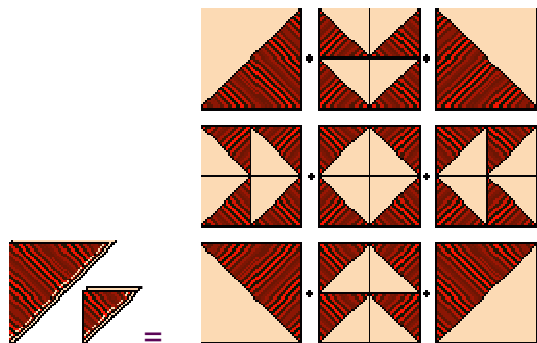


Cut into ten 2-7/8" squares.

Use a pencil or marker to draw a diagonal line (from one corner to the opposite corner) on the reverse side of the lightest square. If you do not have a quarter-inch presser foot, draw two more lines, each one 1/4" from the original diagonal line. Sew two seams, each one 1/4" from the marked center line. Use scissors or rotary cutting equipment to cut through both layers of the square on the marked center diagonal. Press seam to the dark fabric side.

Trim the smaller to 2 1/2" squares  and the larger to 4 1/2 "squares. .

Sew Half square triangle units in rows as pictured. When piecing rows, alternate the direction of the pressing. 12" Finished block measures 12 1/2 unfinished.
