

## May Puyallup Valley Quilter's Block of the Month/2008

Well as our family seeks to sell our home here in Puyallup to move to Virginia after school is over, this will be the last pattern for the block of the month from me. Helen Meeker will be the next block of the month person. So enjoy this last hexagon. :)

Gather 4 materials. A light, medium, dark and very dark. Cut the dark and medium colors into 2 rectangles each 7 inch x 2 ½ inches. Use the pattern-diagram to trim off the edges with a 60 degree angle by laying the triangle against it. Cut 4 equilateral triangles 2 ½ wide from the very dark. Cut 4 equilateral triangles 2 ½ wide from the light. Lay it out ready to sew in strips according to the diagram. Be careful that the triangle will lay flat beside the rectangles after being sewn. Line up the 2 rows and sew them together. To sew other pieces to these, open up the seam so that you can easily sew in strips without hard seams.
