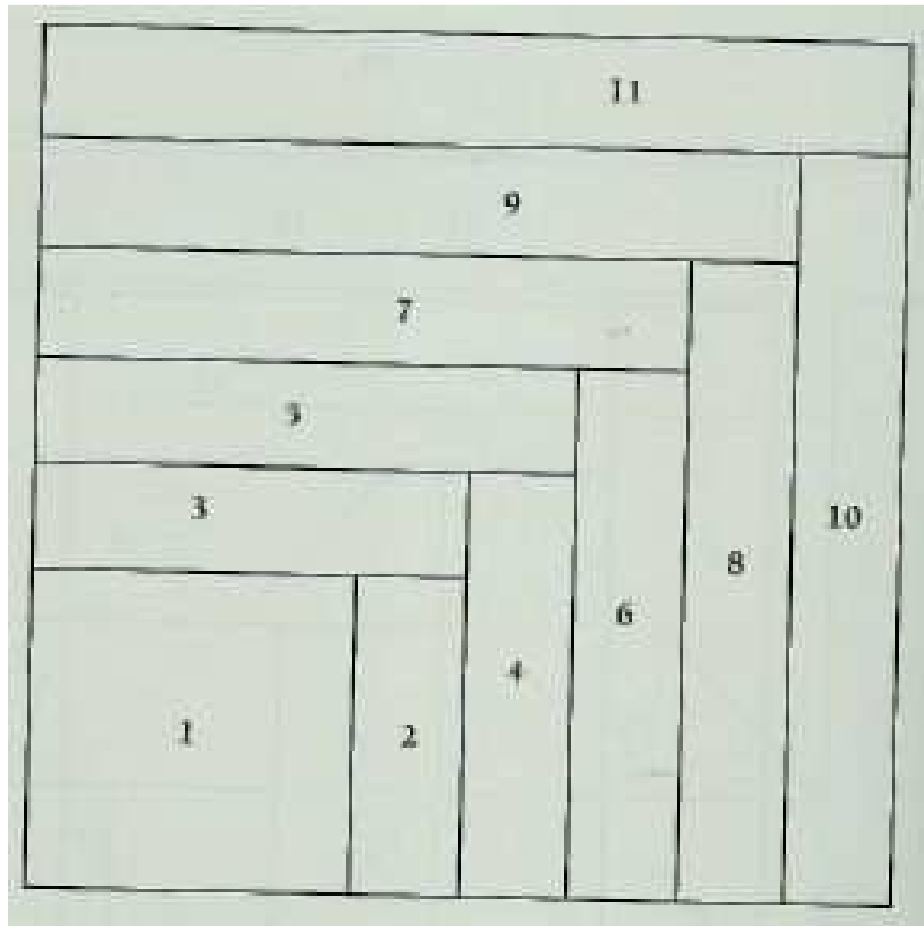


September Log Cabin in the corner



There is really no need to use paper foundation piecing for log cabin quilts.



1. The corner square can be piece or not.

2 – 11. The logs (strips) can be of any width in blacks and whites.

A bright color of the same width should be added in both sides but they should not meet at the corner.

Follow sewing logs (strips) to first Block in the order of numbers indicated.

Finished block should measure 10 ½ inch square. Have fun.
